## on the passage of pedagogical practice by Master Degree's students of EP 7M01311-"Pedagogy and Methods of Primary Education" Pavlodar Pedagogical University

Pedagogical practice by order No. 324 dated 22.09.2020, 5 Master Degree's students of the 2<sup>nd</sup> year of the Educational Program 7M01311-"Pedagogy and Methods of Primary Education" Pavlodar Pedagogical University took place based on the Higher School of Pedagogy from 19.10 to 11.12.2020.

Pedagogical practice consisted in the beyond orientation of Master Degree's students towards pedagogical activities as a teacher and was based either on the knowledge gained by postgraduates in theoretical training courses and on the skills and abilities acquired during training.

The practice is designed to ensure the relationship between the theoretical knowledge obtained by postgraduates in the learning process, and practical activities for the implementation of this knowledge in the workable educational process focused on developing practical skills in public speaking in the classroom, working with methodological literature, creative selection of educational material necessary for teaching, planning the cognitive activity of students and the ability to organize it, the choice of teaching methods and aids that are adequate to the goals and content of educational material, modern educational technologies and active methods of teaching disciplines.
