The program was developed in accordance with the regulatory documents of the Ministry of Science and Higher Education of the Republic of Kazakhstan, taking into account the needs of the labor market in the direction of training masters 7M01611-History (scientific and pedagogical direction).

This master's educational program seems relevant. Its goal is to train specialists with knowledge and skills in the areas of study and analysis of historical issues.

The most important competencies acquired by students of this program include the ability to combine and adapt acquired knowledge to solve problems in the field of professional activity, taking into account modern requirements. The program provides for the development of modern historical methods in organizing research and the application of research methods.

The basis of the master's program is the courses “History and Philosophy of Science”, “Source Studies: Modern Approaches and Practice”, “History of Kazakh Statehood”, “Historical Process and Historical Knowledge”.

One of the advantages is taking into account the requirements of employers when forming disciplines that, in their content, can ensure the graduate's competencies. The quality of the content of the curriculum is beyond doubt. The disciplines included in the plan reveal the essence of historical problems that are relevant today.

The program also provides for gaining experience in a scientific internship. The educational institution is provided with all the necessary resources (information, personnel, material and technical), has access to modern means of organizing the educational process, which allows for various types of classes to train students.

The system for assessing students' mastery of a master's program includes tests, exams and contains automated tools for assessing the completion of practical tasks and a fund of assessment tools for the educational program (materials for current, intermediate and final certification).

This master's program is provided with educational and methodological materials prepared by scientific and pedagogical personnel with appropriate qualifications, which contributes to the formation of professional competencies that meet the standards of higher professional education and the requirements of the labor market.
