

Review
of the bachelor's educational program

of the Higher School of Pedagogy

The reviewed educational program includes its objectives, passport, list of qualifications and positions, the graduate's qualification profile, as well as the scope, objects, subject, types, functions and areas of professional activity, and the educational program map.

The educational program “Special Pedagogy” (hereinafter – the Program) is developed based on the Law of the Republic of Kazakhstan “On Education” dated July 27, 2007, No. 319-III (with amendments and additions as of 04.07.2018), and current regulatory documents of the Republic of Kazakhstan. The content and logic of the Program's structure are determined by the regulatory requirements of the Ministry of Education and Science of the Republic of Kazakhstan and the internal regulations of the university. In designing the educational program, the program director applies scientifically grounded approaches to planning, methodological support, and teaching technologies. The resulting academic coherence of normative and instructional documents ensures effective management of the mechanisms for implementing educational programs. The educational program (hereinafter – the Program) provides training for bachelor's degree specialists in special pedagogy with the educational tracks “Speech Therapy” and “Oligophrenopedagogy.” Cooperation with employers is systematic: there is an established practice of coordinating the program content with regional employers; employers participate in state attestation commissions and evaluate their satisfaction with the quality of specialist training. The structure of the Program allows students to acquire integrated knowledge through modules containing interrelated disciplines. The modular approach ensures step-by-step mastery of the Program. An essential component of the educational program is the sequence of practical training: academic (pedagogical), psychological-pedagogical, industrial (pedagogical), and pre-graduation internships, followed by the preparation of a thesis based on schools and colleges of the city and region that serve as practicum sites. The developed educational program “Special Pedagogy” may be approved and recommended for implementation at Pavlodar Pedagogical University for the training of bachelor-level specialists.
